EXAMINATION & EVALUATION

PRE - PRIMARY WING

The school follows a system of Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation throughout the year for the students of Pre-Primary wing. The grades are given on the basis of class performance, assessments, personality traits and participation in various activities, etc.

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

Class I & II

The academic year for classes I & II has been divided into two Semesters and Examination will be held at the end of each semester.

1 Semester	–	April to September
2 Semester	–	October to March

Each Semester will have two Cycle Tests followed by Terminal Examination at the end of the semester.

The student is also assessed according to the various skills achieved by him/her in Scholastic areas (Main Subjects) and Co-Scholastic areas (such as Art and Craft, Music, Physical Education, etc.)

The overall assessment besides written tests also includes participation and performance in class activities, home work, project work, work sheets, etc.

EVALUATION SYSTEM

1. Semester System for classes III-X has been discontinued per CBSE directions, wef 2022.
2. Students will be graded on 9 point grading scale.
3. Final result will comprise the marks of Annual Exam 60% & Internal Assessment 40% for classes III-V and Annual Exam 80% and Internal Assessment 20% for classes VI-IX.
4. Internal Assessment comprises of Cycle Tests (20% weightage), Notebook Maintenance (10%) & Subject Enrichment Activity (10%) for classes III-V, and Cycle Tests (10% weightage), Notebook Maintenance (5%) & Subject Enrichment Activity (5%) for classes VI-IX.
5. Four Cycle tests will be conducted in a year as per schedule :

 - a) Regularity b) Assignment Completion c) Neatness and upkeep of Notebooks
- Students will be graded for discipline considering the attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values and punctuality.
- Subject enrichment activities will comprise of techniques like ASL/Reading/Dictation/Debate/Public Speaking, etc., for Languages, LAB Activities/Projects/Map Work/Model Making/Field Trips etc.

XI to XII

Assessment is done as per the current CBSE pattern. Cycle Tests are conducted in all the subjects apart from the Terminal and Annual Examinations.

Note:

1. The syllabus for the various tests / examinations has been given in detail in the Syllabus and Activity Calendar.
2. The Students are required to appear in all the Tests / Exams as scheduled. Absence from test/examination would entirely be the responsibility of the parents/guardians. No student should absent himself/herself from any examination or test except in case of serious illness in which case, a medical certificate has to be produced before the commencement of the examination. The final decision in this regard, shall however be taken by the Principal. No grade or rank shall be awarded in case of any kind of absence/leave from test/examination if weightage is given on medical grounds.
3. For class XI the minimum pass percentage is 40% in each subject and in aggregate. Promotion may be denied, if the student gets below 40% marks and there will be no reconsideration of result once it is declared.
4. Parents are requested to examine their wards report carefully, sign it and return it within 3 days of its issue. If it is lost/mutilated by the student, a duplicate card will be issued on payment of Rs.100/-.
5. Failure in examination for two consecutive years will necessitate the withdrawal of the student from the school.
6. Any student found using unfair means during an examination will be marked zero in the subject.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

1. Every Student is expected to maintain, in record, at least 75% attendance during the academic session.
2. In case of sick leave, a proper leave application must be written by the parents to the Principal, supported by a medical certificate.
3. Under no circumstances the student will be allowed to sit in the Annual Examination with attendance below 75% even with medical certificate.
4. If a student misses any class, or leaves the school before time without permission he/she will invite serious action.
5. In case a student is to be withdrawn from the school, one month's notice or one month's fee, in lieu thereof, should be deposited.
6. A student's name will be struck off the rolls if he/she absents himself/herself from the school continuously for 10 days without taking valid leave.
7. No student is allowed to absent himself/herself from the school without prior intimation.

HOUSE SYSTEM IN THE SCHOOL

Students of the school, from class I onwards, are divided into four Houses named after the Brave Hearts Field Marshals & Generals of Indian Army viz. Carriappa, Thimayya, Manekshaw and Sunderji. The House system is primarily to induce a sense of belongingness, spirit of co-operation and tolerance, besides developing an attitude of healthy competition amongst the students. Each house is guided and supervised by the House Incharge, teacher members alongwith their team of House Prefects. All the activities in the school are centered around House System and House on duty has to see to the discipline in the school i.e. in classroom, corridors, lawns, playgrounds and other focal points in the school premises, on weekly basis.

School believes in laying stress on discipline by motivation and persuasion. Senior students are expected to be role models so that their example is emulated.

At the end of the academic session, Houses getting the highest scores in all school activities/competitions are awarded running trophies.

The Students are required to wear T-Shirts of their respective houses on every Wednesday.

KEY TO EXCEL IN EXAMS

- Time Management is an important key to excel in your exams. Time yourself and study accordingly.
- Study frequently so that the topics learnt by you are being refreshed in your mind.
- Make it point to check previous exam pattern to get cues from there.
- Take adequate amount of sleep for 7-8 hours.
- Prefer healthy meals during the exam and refrain from accessing junk food.
- Take a break in between study hours.

METHOD OF STUDY:

- **Duration:** Study for 40-50 minutes at a time with regular breaks of 5-10 minutes each.
- **Avoid Confusion:** Don't study too many fresh topics and subjects on a single day.
- **Skimming:** Fast reading and focusing on key words help concentration and learning.
- **Highlight words and phrases:** This helps you remember them as distinct "photo memories".
- **Make connections between points:** This groups them together to act as a single memory chunk.
- **Use mnemonics:** Flow charts and graphics help you in remembering things.

TAKE A BREAK:

- Simple breathing exercises will help you relax and focus better.
- Leave the study room. Avoid TV, reading and computers. Music, light snacks and walks are more helpful.

REVISION ROUTINE

Typically, memory loss takes place within the first 24 hours of studying, and then weekly. For best recollection, revise every section on day 1, 2, 7, 15 and 30. Maintain the following revision chart to monitor your progress:

Remember, you only need to read your notes and highlighted sections while revising.

SELF-EVALUATION

- Take weekly self tests: Time yourself and give yourself marks.
- Put up a chart in your room and rate yourself on a scale of 0-10 in every subject.

HOW TO SAIL THROUGH EXAMS WITHOUT TROUBLE

BEFORE THE EXAMS

- Make a study schedule with regular, focused and well-spaced sessions.
- Evaluate yourself with self-tests. This will help you focus on the parts where you need to improve.
- Stay healthy with a good diet and plenty of physical activity.
- Take out time for leisure activities.
- Relax and engage in positive discussions.
- Do not make comparisons between your work and anyone else's.
- Revise thoroughly but don't overdo it.
- Get at least 7-8 hours of sleep every night.
- Avoid frantic last minute revisions. They only lead to confusion and stress.
- Talk to your friends about everything except studies.
- Try to minimise the waiting time outside the hall.
- Tell yourself, "I am prepared. I will do well".

DURING THE EXAMS

- Settle down and compose yourself.
- Try a quick relaxation technique - take a few deep breaths.
- Remember, feeling anxious is normal.
- Read the question paper calmly and plan out your time.
- If you don't know an answer, leave it for later and try the next one.
- Leave some extra space after each answer for adding content later.
- There is no need to hurry. This is not a race.
- Don't be bothered by the number of sheets others are taking. Focus on your content.
- Leave some time for revision.

AFTER THE EXAMS

- Avoid getting involved in discussions about the question paper.
- Do not worry about what you may have missed or could have written.
- Give yourself a break and relax at home.
- Resume studies when you feel comfortable.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Beyond the normal curricular of academics, HCPS engages students in myriad of extra-curricular activities to unravel their hidden talents through sports, debates, music, drama and much more.

The activities are designed with an aim to:

- a) **strengthen the core muscles**
- b) **create a stimulating environment**
- c) **teach discipline and co-existence**
- d) **facilitate physical and mental sports**

The above activities are divided into following heads:

- **Special Assembly**
Theme based Morning Assemblies are held to make students comprehend the values of different festivals, events and occasions.
- **Art of Public Speaking**
Elocution, Debates, quizzes, rhyme recitation, news reading, declamation, radio show are done at regular intervals to hone the oratory skills of the children.

Fitness & Well-being Activities

- **Sports**
Games, Aerobics, Gymnastics, Yoga, and Physical training sessions for the physical endurance are taught and practised.
- **Aesthetics**
Hands that work aesthetically, doing different types of Art and Craft activities viz Rangoli, Flower arrangements, Paper quilling, etc.
- **Clubs**
The school facilitated different clubs namely Flameless Cooking, Calligraphy, Band, Music, Library, Yoga to take the talent and skills of the students to the next level.

The above activities have been selected with a specific aim to provide first step to the students towards the vocational education. These activities help students in selecting their hobbies. They also develop individual interest, stimulate thinking and enlighten the spirit of creativity.
